The courses listed here are typically accepted by health professions schools. The HPO has submitted descriptions and syllabi of these courses to the school for their review.

**Students are responsible for comparing the syllabi of your courses to the requirements as described on the TCU website linked above.**

Required coursework must be completed with a letter **grade of C or higher. C- is not accepted for prerequisites.**

TCU considers Credit-by-Exam (such as AP, IB, CLEP) for prerequisites on a case-by-case basis.

<b>Biochemistry</b> (1 course)	<b>BCH 369 or BCH 339F</b>	Lab is not required.
<b>Genetics</b> (1 course)	<b>BIO 325</b>	Lab is not required.
<b>Physiology</b> (1 course)	<b>BIO 365S</b>	Lab is not required.
<b>Statistics</b> (1 course)	<b>SDS 328M</b>	Read content requirement details on school website to determine options.
<b>English Composition</b> (1 course)	<b>RHE 306 or RHE 309K</b>	
<b>Social/Behavioral Sciences</b> (2 courses)	Examples: <b>PSY 301</b> <b>SOC 302</b> <b>ANT 302</b>	
<b>Humanities</b> (2 courses)	Examples: <b>ART, MUS, TD, CMS,</b> <b>E 316L, M, N, or P,</b> <b>PHL, SPN</b>	

**If you are trying to use other courses to satisfy any of these requirements, compare the courses' syllabi to the content requirements on the TCU website linked above.**
