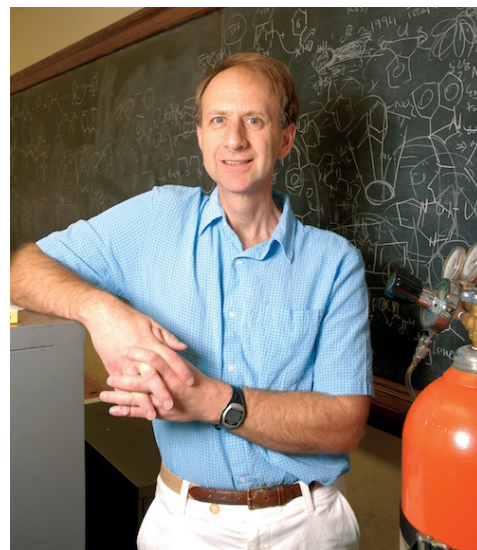
Jonathan L. Sessler Endowed Graduate Student Fellowship in Chemistry

Established by former students, friends and colleagues of Dr. Jonathan Sessler

Friends, former students and colleagues of Professor Jonathan Sessler have joined together to establish the *Jonathan L. Sessler Endowed Graduate Student Fellowship in Chemistry*. The endowment will be a tribute to Dr. Sessler's 30 years of research, teaching, and service. Sessler has written extensively, authoring or co-authoring over 350 publications. In addition, he has co-authored two books and edited a third. He holds more than 70 U.S. patents. Dr. Sessler has received many awards and much recognition, as a Sloan Fellow (1999), Fellow of the AAAS (1999), Dreyfus Teacher-Scholar (1999), ACS Cope Scholar (1999), recipient of the JSPS and Alexander von Humboldt Senior Fellowships (1999), and winner of the Izatt-Christensen Award (1999). The endowment will support, in perpetuity, the Department of Chemistry at The University of Texas at Austin. This endowment requires gifts and pledges of \$50,000 to reach its goal. All pledges in support of the *Sessler Fellowship* may be paid over a five-year window.

Funds distributed annually from the *Jonathan L. Sessler Endowed Graduate Student Fellowship in Chemistry* will be used to support graduate students studying chemistry at the University. This support will allow the College to grow the next generation of chemists and will greatly enhance the programmatic experience.

In light of the extraordinary opportunity to establish a named fellowship in honor of Jonathan Sessler, the College of Natural Sciences looks to the former students, friends and colleagues of Dr. Sessler to support this initiative. Dr. Sessler's impact on UT and the chemistry department has been profound, and his research in the field of bioorganic and drug discovery chemistry has made significant impacts in the study of chemistry.

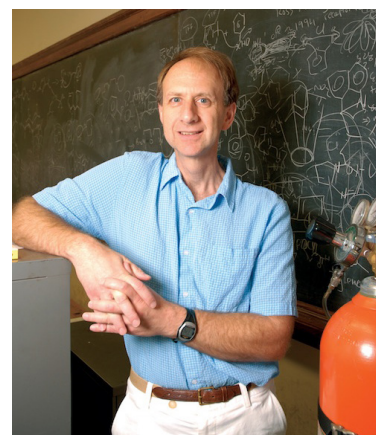
